Rules and Regulations:

- The rates will be \$250 per table (8ft table, and two chairs). \$50 more for corner.
- The rates will be \$150 per small table (for Mahendi, Not for Profit organizations)
Early Bird discount of \$50 when payment is received in full by July 31, 2016.
- Please bring your own table cloths/decorations etc.
- Vendors must stay within their allotted space 12 ft. X 12 ft. per table).
- Restaurants rates are \$550 for two 8 ft tables in the front, one table in the back. \$100 more for corner. (includes half page advertisement in the souvenir brochure)
Early bird discount of \$50 when payment received in full before 31 July, 2016
- Restaurants are not to sell any beverages (including bottled water, soda, lassi, masala chai).
- Restaurants will be responsible for obtaining permits (license) from the town of Fairfield, pay for them and comply with all applicable Fire, Safety, Health and other codes and regulations by all the rules laid out by the Health Department of the town. (Wear gloves, cover your hair etc.) Food vendors will pay for their permits.
- Vendors are responsible for removing their items and clean up after the event.
- Vendors can use pop-up canopies, but cannot dig any holes in the ground.
- Vendors are NOT allowed to:
 - Use any kind of audio (P.A.) system (speakers, microphones) etc.
 - Display banners; distribute any literature etc. outside their booth space.
 - Harass the visitors in any way.
- Heritage India Festival is a community and family oriented event. Vendors are expected to honor the spirit of the event, and only exhibit items, which are generally accepted at family events.
- HCC reserves the right to expel any vendor from the Festival for boisterous conduct, misrepresentations of display exhibits or items sold, illegal activity, failure to obey HCC rules and regulations, or failure to comply with any reasonable request made by HCC.
